Company, industry and occupational overviews, career guides, college surveys and message boards.

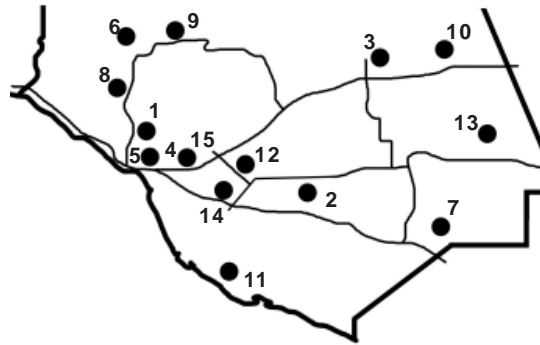
